Concordia confers degrees in May, August, and December each year. Check one of these choices.

You have one opportunity to participate in the annual May commencement ceremony. If you are a December graduate then you will participate in the ceremony following your graduation date. If you are an August graduate then you may participate in the commencement ceremony prior to graduation if you have 6 or fewer hours left to complete.

Early participation in commencement: If you have 6 or fewer hours remaining (or DCE internship) you may ask to participate in the commencement ceremony prior to completing your degree.

Please note that there is a non-refundable \$65 (plus tax) commencement fee – ordered and paid through the Concordia Bookstore. (Fee is subject to change. Regalia includes cap, gown, hood and tassel.) Please pay the bookstore when you pick up your gown during the week of commencement. Degrees and Majors

You may earn more than one type of degree (BA-Bachelor of Arts, BS-Bachelor of Science, BSED-Bachelor of Science in Education, BFA-Bachelor of Fine Arts, or BMUS-Bachelor of Music). However you must make certain that you have completed an additional 30 semester hours for each additional degree. You may earn more than one major as long as the additional major(s) is/are available with the degree you will earn and the requirements for the major are completed.

Please note that a minimum of 128 credit hours for one degree (and 158 for two degrees) is required for most students graduating in 2015-16. Please see the Registrar's Office for exceptions to this requirement. *Review your transcript and degree requirements prior to submitting this application to make sure that you are on track to graduate.*

Minors

Most minors are available with any degree/major and are awarded only with a major. A minor cannot be earned in the same field as a major. You may have more than one minor.

Signatures

You and your advisor must sign the form.

Pre-Seminary students are required to obtain the signature of the Director of the Pre-Seminary Program and DCE students should obtain the signature of the DCE director.

Diplomas

If you are a December or August graduate then your diploma will be mailed to you. May graduates not participating in the commencement ceremony will also have their diplomas mailed. May graduates participating in the commencement ceremony will receive their diploma at commencement. A financial hold will prevent the issuing of a diploma and final transcript until all financial obligations have been met.

Return this completed form to the Office of the Registrar by the due date for your selected graduation date. Due dates for applications for the 2015-16 academic year are as follows:

December 2015 graduates: September 18, 2015
May and August 2016 graduates: January 22, 2016
May 2017 (DCE only) graduates: January 22, 2016
